`Grow Green' helps Fairy Godmothers grant more wishes

MANHATTAN, KANSAS, April 16, 2018 -- Grow Green/Match Day is a day set aside to pay yearly dues or make donations to the Fairy Godmothers organization and earn a 50 percent match up to \$20,000.

Fairy Godmothers are an affiliate of the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation, a non-profit organization. This group was established by women wanting to help other women in the Manhattan area.

This special day April 20 is an opportunity to grow the Fairy Godmothers' Endowments to enrich our programs for even greater impact for years to come and assist with annual campaigns. On this day, the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation will provide a 50 percent match on donations made to participating endowment funds.

This HUG is a financial assistance award for a course or certification program that will lead to employment or job advancement. The candidate must be a resident of Manhattan or Riley County and a U.S. citizen.
